Report on Trust and General Fund Disbursements to 2025 Annual General Meeting

January 1, 2025 – December 31, 2025

Trust Fund

This is the fourth year of Disbursement Advisory Committee (DAC) allocating funds from the Trust Fund. The DAC accepts applications for funding by January 31 of the year preceding the year of the event. By the deadline of January 31st 2025, we received several applications for travel in 2026. This speaks to the increasing awareness of the funding opportunities.
